2021 NEWS - A NEW LOCATION

The 5th CMP Venice Night Trail will be even more comfortable and safe, thanks to the new starting area at Terminal 123 that will allow you to park your car FOR FREE and in a GUARDED AREA a stone's throw from the start and the bib number pick up, in the heart of the the CMP Venice Running Village!

This year in which we are trying to start again and come back to normality you need to follow all the rules established by the Authorities. We therefore encourage you to read with attention all the information reported below.

RESPECT THE COVID 19 PROTOCOL

1)BRING WITH YOU THE COVID SELF-CERTIFICATION FORM ALREADY SIGNED

2)USE YOUR CAR TO CHANGE CLOTHES AND LEAVE YOUR BAG IN IT

3)BRING WITH YOU THE NECESSARY TO COOL YOURSELF AND HYDRATE DURING THE RACE

4)REMEMBER TO WEAR ALWAYS THE FACE-MASK, YOU WILL TAKE IT OFF ONLY 500m AFTER THE START AND YOU WILL HAVE TO WEAR IT AGAIN WHEN YOU CROSS THE FINISH LINE

5)SANITIZE YOUR HANDS OFTEN

6)ALWAYS MAINTAIN THE SECURITY DISTANCE DURING THE RACE

7)PAY ATTENTION TO ALL THE INDICATIONS THE SPEAKER WILL TELL YOU

8)AVOID GATHERING AT THE BIB NUMBERS PICK-UP AND AFTER THE FINISH LINE

9)RESPECT THE START PROCEDURES

10)ALWAYS THROW YOUR TRASH INTO THE APPOSITE WASTEBINS

GENERAL COVID RULES





Sport Licence

The event is open to all athletes aged at least 10. Nordic walkers and fit walkers included.

Underage athletes need the authorization of a parent or of anybody having their custody.

With the registration each participant declares to be in healthy condition to take part in the race. With this form the athlete waives, releases and forever discharges the event organizers for all his/her liabilities, claims, actions, or damages that he/she may have against them arising out of or in any way connected with the participation in the race.



Recommended equipment

For safety reasons it is mandatory to participate wearing a headlamp and sportswear.



Book your Hotel

Revolugo is the CMP Venice Night Trail official travel app.

Your hotel booking, personal data and privacy are protected and secured. Accommodation requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis and based on availability. Check the list! Is something missing??

Before leaving home or the hotel check if something is missing:

- The documents to get the bib number
- The proper clothes to race (suitable for the weather conditions!!!!)
- The headlamp
- Some dry clothes to get changed after the race
- **The FACE-MASK that you have to wear in all the steps before and after the race. You will take it off only 500m after the start and you will have to wear it again when you cross the finish line.**



Official photos

Download the Pica APP from [Apple Store](#) or [Google Play](#). After the finish line you could view your race photos!

Keep smiling! The PICA photographers will get shots of you during your race. Look for them along the race course and when you see them move to one side your headlamp and smile. After the race visit the official website [getpica.com](#) or open the app, type your PICA CODE and have a look at your photos.



Venice Running Village

Visit the Venice Running Village at Venezia Tronchetto - Cruise Terminal 123. Here you will find all services set up for the participants in the race and the sponsor village. The Venice Running Village is open on Saturday 28th August 2021 from 3pm to 11pm.

How to get to the Venice Running Village – Venezia Tronchetto – Cruise Terminal 123



If you reach the start line by car

From turnpike A13 direction "Bologna to Padova":

– Go ahead the tollgate 'Padova Zona Industriale' and follow the road signals to Venezia A57

– After the tollgate "Mestre – Villabona" (Venezia-Mestre) take the first exit on your right immediately and follow the road signals to Venezia.

From turnpike A4 direction "Milano to Trieste":

– Go ahead the tollgate 'Padova Est' and follow the road signals to Venezia A57

– After the tollgate "Mestre – Villabona" (Venezia-Mestre) take the first exit on your right immediately and follow the road signals to Venezia.

From turnpike A4 direction "Trieste to Milano":

– Go ahead the tollgate "Noventa di Piave" and follow the road signals to Venezia, then go ahead to the Mestre bypass, take the exit "PORTO" and follow the road signals to Venezia.

– Take the Mestre overpass and go on following the road signals to Venezia.

- Cross the "Ponte della Libertà", causeway connecting Venezia to the mainland.
- At the end of the bridge at the first traffic light turn to your right.
- Go ahead for 200 meters downhill up to the Stop sign. In front of you, you will see the entranceway to the Port of Venice indicated by the sign of the "Autorità Portuale di Venezia - Venezia Terminal Passeggeri S.p.A".

Closed to the start line and the village of the race you will find a lot of free car parks, but if you are a group of friends or if you arrive with your family we recommend you to use less cars possible giving the possibility to all participants to find a car park to leave the car.

If you reach the start line from railway station

Drop off to St. Lucia Railway Station (Venice Historical Center), go to the right and walk across the "Costituzione" bridge (Ponte di Calatrava) to arrive at Piazzale Roma, then catch the People Mover that connect P.le Roma to Cruise Terminal station in 3 minutes or walk for 15 minutes to reach the destination.



If you reach the start line by bus or tram

Drop off to Piazzale Roma, from here you can catch the People Mover that connect P.le Roma to Cruise Terminal station in 3 minutes or walk for 15 minutes to reach the destination.



If you reach the start line by water bus

Catch the line n. 2 and drop off to the Tronchetto stop, then catch the People Mover to arrive in 3 minutes to the destination or walk for 15 minutes.

Bib number pick up

From Monday 23rd to Tuesday 24th you will receive via email the confirmation letter; it is the only document to get your starting number.

The bib number can be picked up at the Venice Running Village in Venice Tronchetto - Cruise Terminal 123 on Saturday 28th from 3pm to 7pm.

Remember that you need to show to our staff your confirmation letter on your Smartphone, your ID Card and hand out your Covid self-certification form and all the missing documents if requested.

DO NOT PRINT YOUR CONFIRMATION LETTER but show it to our volunteers directly from your smartphone.

Important notice! We remind you that if the documents of your registration are not correct you won't be able to take part in the race.



Race kit pick up

After getting the bib number, remember to take your race kit and the official technical t-shirt which can be customized by "IL NEGOZIETTO" - you could ask to have your name or your surname or even your nickname on it. Due to Covid situation you cannot wear or change the official technical t-shirt.

AVOID GATHERING ALSO DURING THE BIB NUMBER AND RACE KIT PICK UP AND ALWAYS FOLLOW THE COMMUNICATIONS THAT OUR STAFF WILL PROVIDE YOU FOR ACCESS AND STAY IN THE AREAS OF THE VILLAGE AND SANITIZE YOUR HANDS OFTEN WITH THE CITROSIL SANITIZING GEL THAT YOU WILL FIND IN THE VILLAGE.



Personal kit bag

IN ORDER TO AVOID GATHERING, WE KINDLY ASK YOU TO USE YOUR CAR OR YOUR ROOM OF THE HOTEL AS A CHANGING ROOM AND BAG STORAGE.

For those who reach the Terminal by public transport, a bag storage service and a covered area for changing rooms will be provided.

You will find toilets in the Terminal 123 area.



The start

The start will be divided into different waves of up to 500 participants interspersed with sufficient time to allow the athletes to leave the corral before the start of the next wave. The start of the first corral is scheduled at about 9pm on Saturday 28th August from Venezia Tronchetto - Cruise Terminal 123.

When you enter the corral you will have to respect the distance from the other athletes and place yourself on one of the signs on the ground.

REMEMBER TO WEAR THE FACE-MASK CORRECTLY IN ALL THE PRE-START PHASES AND FOR THE FIRST 500m OF RACE.



Corral access

The access to the individual starting corrals will be manned by our staff who will allow access only to athletes with bibs matched to each corral.

To access your corral, follow the signs that will be posted throughout the area and strictly respect the time that will be indicated in the confirmation letter.



Timing

Thanks to the Timing Data Service transponder stuck at your bib number, you will be timed the time you take to complete the race. Remember not to remove it or you won't be timed. **Important notice!! The transponder is disposable so you DO NOT HAVE to give it back after the race.**



In case of emergency

Should you be unable to finish the race, do not panic! There are lots of volunteers along the course ask them to tell you how to get to the finish line or they will ask for a first aid service.

In addition, running by your side there will be the athletes of the BLS-RUN-TEAM "...rianimatoriINCorsa ..." a group of runners enabled to cardiopulmonary resuscitation and early defibrillation.



Traffic is open – BE CAREFUL!!!

You do not run among cars but among pedestrians!!!

Have a look at people around you, there are plenty of volunteers along the race course but pedestrians can walk around, therefore be careful and do not bump against them especially in the narrowest paths....and when crossing bridges mind the steps bridges are very insidious!!



Time limit

The maximum time to complete the race is **3h00'**.



Race Course

Over 200 volunteers will stand along the race course to mark it out!

After the start at Venezia Tronchetto the race course will snake along the harbor area to enter then Piazzale Roma through the bridge below the People Mover. The race course will go on passing for the first time the Grand Canal through the Calatrava bridge and will enter the heart of the real Venice, it will go through the typical and picturesque Calli and Campielli to reach the Biennale to lead afterwards to Saint Mark Sq. The race will pass by La Fenice theater, will cross the Grand Canal through the Accademia bridge and then it will go left to Punta della Dogana. It will run along Fondamenta delle Zattere by the Canale della Giudecca to reach the finish line in Tronchetto.



Course Amenties

We encourage you to bring everything you will need with you during the race.

At about half of the race course, you will find a refreshment station with [San Benedetto](#) water, energetic drinks by [Pro Action](#) and [Palmisano](#) biscuits.

All products delivered will be individually wrapped and the bottles of water will be delivered unopened.

At the refreshment stations our staff will sort you between the various tables, we invite you not to stop except for the strictly necessary time to take the products in order to avoid gatherings.



Fountains

Along the race course several public fountains will be available for athletes to refresh.

Finish line

The finish line is located in Venice Tronchetto – Cruise Terminal 123.

After the finish line you will find the delivery point of the final refreshment bag with [San Benedetto](#) water, [Proaction](#) supplements, [Palmisano](#) biscuits, [Vitamil](#) products and [Bavaria](#) beer to toast to your performance and the medal of participation that unfortunately this year we cannot put around your neck.
